Don't wreck your environment as so many other North American communities have done. My province of New Brunswick has a moratorium, and so should you. There is no proven safe method of disposing of that chemical-laden waste water. Do you really want to have that in your communities? And all that methane let loose - much more of a dangerous greenhouse gas than CO2. And as for jobs - not many and not long-lasting. I went to NewfounIdland once to visit a friend. I've often thought it would be nice to return, because it is such an interesting place. But I wouldn't go if you fracked it up - no way.
